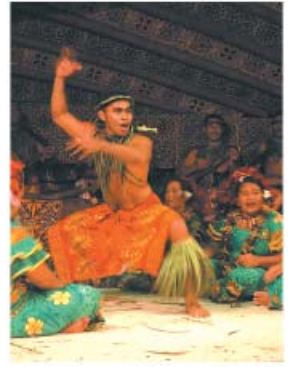
## Peru's Spanish-Colonial Cusco and the Incan Citadel of Machu Picchu (2 days)

Enjoy the hospitality and unspoiled beauty of tropical Samoa — considered by many as the cradle of Polynesian culture.



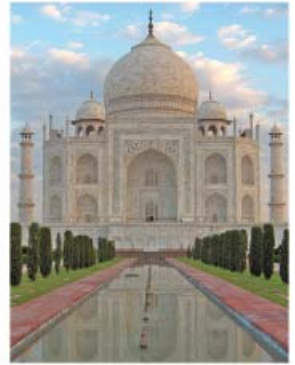
## Extraordinary Marine Life of the Great Barrier Reef in Australia (2 days)

Visit the legendary Taj Mahal at Agra, and embrace one of history's most remarkable architectural wonders — one of the seven wonders of the modern world.



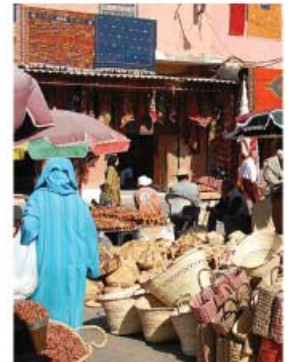
## Safari Adventure in Tarangire National Park, Serengeti Plain, or Ngorongoro Crater (2 days)
