### Spain Grand Journey

Travel through the most historic regions of northern Spain. Follow in the footsteps of ancient Phoenicians, Carthaginians, Greeks, Romans, and Moors — peoples who once called this land home and who left behind extraordinary vestiges of their presence. Each group contributed to the rich traditions and colorful culture of modern Spain. This special program begins in cosmopolitan Madrid and features five UNESCO World Heritage Sites: the old towns of Segovia, Ávila, and Salamanca; Burgos Cathedral, and the architecture of Barcelona's Antoni Gaudí.

#### Daily Itinerary

- 1 depart for Madrid.
- 2 arrive in Madrid and transfer to the Hotel Wellington. Spend the rest of the day at leisure. Attend the welcome reception.
- 3 take a tour of Madrid and spend the afternoon at leisure.
- 4 visit the Museo del Prado and enjoy an afternoon at leisure.
- 5 visit historic Segovia and the walled city of Ávila. Stay at the Palacio de los Velada Hotel.
- 6 visit Salamanca.
- 7 transfer to Laguardia and the Hotel Villa de Laguardia. Visit Burgos and a winery.
- 8 take a guided tour of Laguardia.
- 9 visit Bilbao and the Guggenheim Museum.
- 10 transfer to Barcelona and stay at the Majestic Hotel & Spa. Visit Zaragoza on the way.
- 11 enjoy a city tour of Barcelona. Spend an afternoon at leisure.
- 12 see the work of architect Antoni Gaudí. Spend the afternoon at leisure. Attend the evening farewell reception.
- 13 transfer to the airport and return home.
