- 5 visit the College of Piping and Celtic Performing Arts of Canada and enjoy Celtic music. Arrive in Charlottetown, Prince Edward Island, and stay at the Great George Hotel.
- 6 tour Prince Edward Island.
- 7 ferry to Nova Scotia and visit Cape Breton Island. Arrive in Baddeck and stay at the Auberge Gisele’s Inn.
- 8 journey along Cabot Trail.
- 9 visit Grand-Pré National Historic Site. Enjoy the farewell dinner.
- 10 transfer to Halifax airport and return home.
