Begin your journey in Nairobi. Visit Daphne Sheldrick's elephant orphanage, and feed the rare Rothschild giraffe. Cross the equator to get close to Grévy's zebras, gerenuks, and other unique wildlife in the harsh but beautiful Samburu National Reserve, home of the extraordinary Samburu people. At Sweetwaters reserve, watch a parade of elephants, giraffes, and zebras drink at the camp's floodlit waterhole, visit the renowned chimpanzee sanctuary, or join a ranger patrol to monitor black rhinos. Explore the magnificent Great Rift Valley, and count the vibrant flamingoes on Lake Nakuru. Visit a native village and search for the "Big Five" across the Maasai Mara Reserve — the Jewel of Africa. Home to zebras, wildebeests, gazelles, warthogs, buffaloes, and the predators that stalk them: lions, cheetahs, and more; the Mara is the epitome of the East African safari experience. Optional activities abound, and an extension is available to Tsavo West National Park and Amboseli National Park at the base of Mount Kilimanjaro.



Daily Itinerary

- 1-2 board overnight flight to London. Depart London for Nairobi.
- 3 arrive in Nairobi and visit the Nairobi Safari Park Hotel.
- 4-5 depart for Samburu Reserve and the Elephant Bedroom Camp.
- 6 visit the Sweetwaters tented camp and enjoy the day's wildlife drive.
- 7-8 tour Lake Nakuru National Park and enjoy the wildlife drives and Mbweha Camp.
- 9-11 tour the Maasai Mara-Northern Serengeti. Take in three days of wildlife viewing at the Mara Tipilikwani Camp.
- 12 savor a final opportunity to photograph the sunrise, return to Nairobi for the afternoon, and board an evening return flight to London.
- 13 catch morning connections for flights home.
