Warm Southern Hospitality — Up North Journey Through Vietnam

Experience the natural beauty, enduring traditions, and warm hospitality of Vietnam. Tour the capital, Hanoi, and take a full-day excursion to the magical Ha Long Bay, which includes 3,000 diverse islands and islets. In Da Nang, tour the acclaimed Cham Museum and view its many artifacts and sculptures. Travel to the countryside, and visit small farming settlements set against the backdrop of fields of rice paddies. Visit the ancient imperial capital, Hue, and the impressive tombs of emperors and mandarins. Cruise the Perfume River to peaceful Thien Mu Pagoda, a Buddhist monastery, and one of Hue's most important sites. In southern Vietnam, explore the tributaries and floating markets of the vital Mekong River Delta. In spirited, cosmopolitan Ho Chi Minh City, formerly known as Saigon, see the Reunification Palace, the Museum of History, and the underground Cu Chi Tunnels used during the Vietnam War. A four-day, three-night post-tour extension to Angkor Wat and Phnom Penh, Cambodia, is available.

- 3-4 tour Hanoi.
- 5 visit Ha Long Bay.
- 6 fly to Hue and check in to the Hotel Saigon Morin.
- 7 visit Thien Mu Pagoda. Visit the tomb of Minh Mang.
- 8 tour Da Nang. Check in to Furama Resort Da Nang.
- 9 visit Hoi An.
- 10 visit Chau Hoa. Spend the rest of the day at leisure.
- 11 visit Cái Bè, Can Tho, and the Mekong Delta. Check in to the Victoria Chn Thu Resort.
- 12 visit the Cái Răng district and the Mekong Museum.
- 13 visit the upper reaches of the Mekong, Ho Chi Minh City, and check in to the Sofitel Plaza Saigon.
- 14 tour Ho Chi Minh City. Enjoy an afternoon at leisure.
- 15 visit the Cu Chi Tunnels. Spend the remainder of the day at leisure.
- 16 return home.
