- 8 travel from Venice to Rome through Tuscany and the Apennine Mountains. (B)
- 9 see Rome at your leisure. (B, D)
- 10 travel from Rome to Florence through rural Umbria. (B)
- 11 from Florence visit Lucerne with a scenic drive past Milan and Lake Como. (B, D)
- 12 travel from Lucerne to Paris, and see the "City of Lights." (B, D)
- 13 tour Paris at your leisure. (B)
- 14 depart Paris and return home. (B)
