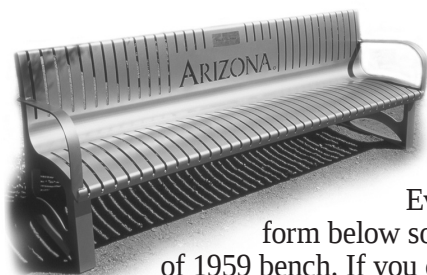
50-Year Reunion at Homecoming
