To Whom It May Concern:

In 1982 an enthusiastic group of 125 UA graduates gathered in the Arizona Stadium Club to begin a bold experiment we now know as the UA Hispanic Alumni (UAHA). By evenings end the first officers were selected and the group was entrusted with the dream of promoting excellence among the Hispanic students at the University.

Our student community has grown and today we make up 14% of the student population. The UA Hispanic Alumni Club is an integral part of that growth through advocacy, financial support and campus involvement. For the 1986-87 academic years, the UAHA awarded 7 scholarships totaling \$9,800. For our current academic year of 2008-09, we will be awarding 243 student scholarship awards to the total amount of \$500,000. In the past 24 years UAHA has awarded over 1,760 scholarship totaling \$3,942,594; however, there are still many students in need of our and your assistance. We realize the economic downturn and tuition increases will be affecting the financial needs of our current and incoming students.

UAHA scholarship recipients participate in our retention programs that provide the fundamental tools for them to be successful during their course of study and also introduce them to a network of working professionals in various fields. The retention and graduation rate for our recipients hovers at 90% while the national average is 55% for Hispanics. This remarkable outcome has made the UAHA a model for other University Hispanic Alumni groups in the Nation.

We continue to develop and expand our programs for Hispanic students and the community. The UAHA has created the Multi-Cultural Community & Career Expo to provide employment, internship and mentorship opportunities at a local, national and international level. Our Annual Scholarship Dinner continues to be our most successful scholarship and programs fund raising event of the year. Homecoming *Pachanga* and Hispanic Heritage Tailgate & Game bring together students, faculty, staff, alumni and the local community to renew old friendships and forge new ones.

The UAHA scholarship fund and other programs would have limited success if it were not for the generous support and contributions of individuals and corporations in our community. We look forward to your continued or initial contribution and support for the UA Hispanic Alumni and the many Hispanic students who will directly benefit from it.
